

A **prayer flag** is a colorful rectangular cloth, often found strung along mountain ridges and peaks high in the **Himalayas.** They are used to bless the surrounding countryside.

Please pick up a blank prayer flag from the table in the narthex. Take it home, write a prayer, decorate, and pray over your flag. We want to hold the country of Nepal in prayer as they continue to recover from their devastating earthquakes. Bring the flag back and it will be used to decorate the church as we lead up to our Mt. Everest VBS in August.
